BAPTISM:

The sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on weekends.

Baptisms will be celebrated *during* the following Masses: 5PM Saturday Vigil Mass (Eng.), Sunday 8AM (Eng.) 9:30AM(Polish), or 4PM (Spanish). (*Note:* Baptisms during the 4PM Spanish Mass are celebrated on the 2nd and 4th Sundays of the month.) Parents who want to arrange a Baptism need to come to the rectory office and provide the child's birth certificate. Parents of first children are required to receive instruction prior to the baptism. Those chosen as Godparents must be practicing, Confirmed Catholics whose lives reflect a commitment to the Catholic faith and to the role of Godparent. All Godparents need to obtain a document of sponsorship from the parish *where they are registered members*.

MARRIAGES: Arrange *at least* six months before the date.

DEVOTIONS:

May: Litany to the Blessed Virgin Mary after each Sunday Mass

October: Decade of the Rosary after Sunday Masses

Lent: Stations of the Cross every Friday after the 7:30 AM Mass in English; 7:30 PM in Polish.

Gorzkie Żale on Sundays in Lent following the 9:30 AM Polish Mass.

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL PARISH VOLUNTEERS

The Office for the Protection of Children and Young People will be undertaking an audit to ascertain that all those who volunteer in any parish or Diocesan organization are in compliance with the safe environment requirements listed below. *Saint Ladislaus volunteers who are missing any of the requirements will receive a note in the mail in the next two weeks.* A person wishing to volunteer must first complete three requirements:

- Attend Protecting God’s Children (Virtus)
 - Sign the Codes of Conduct.
 - Complete a background screening application. *(The background screening is conducted on all volunteers and employees every 5 years.)*
1. Sign up to attend a Protecting God’s Children class: www.Virtus.org. *If you have not attended a class, you are a first time registrant.* When asked the name of your organization, select **Rockville Centre-Safe Environment** from the drop-down list.
 2. Follow all directions to register.
 3. After you have selected a class to attend, you will be instructed to complete the background screening application, which is provided by Sterling Volunteers.
 4. Follow all directions to complete the screening application. **DO NOT STOP ONCE YOU BEGIN THE APPLICATION!** If you stop, you will be locked out of the process due to security procedures,
 5. You will need to provide your Social Security number; if you do not provide this number, you will be charged a fee.
 6. After completing the application, hit the **SUBMIT** button.
